

SHIELDX ROOF TILE PAINT

1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

ShieldX Roof Tile Paint is a single pack 100% acrylic coating used for the refurbishment of old but structurally sound, discoloured roof tiles.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

COLOURS: Black, brown and grey. **FINISH:** Semi-matt finish.

SPECIFIC GRAVITY: 1.1 - 1.2g VOLUME SOLIDS: 40% approx.

PRACTICAL COVERAGE: 6 sqm per litre depending on surfaces. **FILM THICKNESS:** 45 microns dft

VOC:/litre: 140g/l

3. SURFACE PREPARATION

Most roofs have growth of algae, lichens and fungi, which must be completely treated with Castle multi-surface fungicidal treatment and completely removed before painting. It is normal to allow fungicidal treatment 72 hours to kill growths in dry weather before painting.

4. APPLICATION DETAILS

Apply 2 - 3 coats thinning the first coat 3:1 (3 parts paint: 1 part water). Subsequent coats can be applied directly.

APPLICATION METHOD: Brush or spray.

THINNER: Water only.

DRYING TIME: Allow 8 hours between coats. Do not apply in conditions below 10 degrees Celsius.

5. STORAGE & HANDLING

STORAGE: Always store and transport in a secure upright position. Store the closed container in a cool dry place. Keep away from extremes of temperature.

PACK SIZE: 10 Litre.

6. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Paint product flammable.
- Keep away from sources of ignition.
- Do not take internally.
- Keep out of the reach of children.
- In case of contact with eyes rinse immediately with plenty of water.
- In case of insufficient ventilation wear suitable respiratory equipment.
- Remove splashes from skin using soap and water or a recognised skin cleaner.
- Dispose of container and contents in accordance with local/national regulations.
- Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.
- Contains no added lead.
